Entry Fee

To be judged or enter the exhibit, a \$40 entry fee is required with your application (up to 2 entries). Registration includes admission to Historic Collinsville and lunch for participants. **Additional entries carry a fee of \$10 per entry.** Payment is accepted by check or online at www.artsandheritage.us via PayPal. (Checks should be made payable to Arts and Heritage Council. Artists will be charged \$15 on returned checks.)

Exhibition Guidelines

You must be a registered participant in order to exhibit in the show! Deadline for participation sign-up is September 16, 2023.

- Registration begins at 9:00 a.m., September 22 and 23, at Historic Collinsville.
- An official ID stamp will be placed on the backs of **blank** canvases and/or other grounds.
- Artists are requested to paint in the assigned area during the two-day event.
- Painting locations and subjects are limited to Historic Collinsville.
- Artists may display two paintings from the event during the exhibition on Thursday, October 5.
- Artwork size **excluding frame**, must be at least 5" on one side and no more than 20" on one side.
- Artwork must have wire hangers (no saw-tooth hangers).
- **Accepted Media:** Almost all Painting and Drawing Media. **Not Accepted:** Crafts, Photography, Computer-Generated Art, or Prints/Giclee.
- **Submit final entries by 3 p.m. on Saturday, September 23, to be juried and exhibited.**
- All work must be framed or matted for easier handling, since paintings may be wet. However, the 2Rivers Identifying Stamp on the back of finished works must be clearly visible to be eligible for judging.
- **To be judged, all artwork will be held at VisitClarksville for the October 5 exhibition and awards ceremony. It must be picked up at the end of the exhibition on October 5.** Please inform us in writing if someone other than

yourself will be picking up your artwork(s).

Additional Notes

Art for sale is strongly encouraged.

Art must be labeled on the back with name of artist, title, size and price. All work must be framed or matted for easier handling with wire hangers (not saw tooth hangers). We will strive to hang as many works as possible and all works will be displayed in an appealing way.

Arts and Heritage reserves the right to use all art for promotional purposes. Individual artists are responsible for insuring their own art.

To support the maintenance and educational mission of Historic Collinsville, a 25% commission on sales of guest artists will go to this Montgomery County attraction. In the event of a sale, checks will be made out to VisitClarksville, and buyer may take art at point of sale. Artists will be paid 75% of the sale. Artists are responsible for paying the sales tax.

Reception and Awards Ceremony

A reception and exhibition will be held on Thursday, October 5, 2023, from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. in F & M Bank's Franklin Room, 50 Franklin Street, Clarksville Tennessee 37041. The award ceremony will take place at 5:30 p.m.

Historic Collinsville Plein Air Workshop, September 16, 2023



Award-winning artist, Kitty Harvill, will conduct a free plein air workshop for the first 15 applicants in the restored village of Historic Collinsville from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturday, September 16, 2023. Recipient of the prestigious international 2022 Simon Combes Conservation Award, Kitty Harvill was born in Clarksville. She received her BFA cum laude in painting from SMU including a semester of study in Paris, an MA in Art Therapy from the University of Illinois at Chicago, and an AA in illustration from Ray College, Chicago.

She has dedicated herself to painting nature and wildlife art since 2006. Harvill's works in watercolor, pastel, oil and acrylic have garnered numerous international awards. Her work is included in corporate, museum and private collections in the USA, Brazil, Germany,
